

Reading: Matthew 6:9 - 13

#### Introduction/Recap

- There are 3 types of kingdoms referred to in the Bible.
- The kingdoms of men, Satan's kingdom & the Kingdom of God.
- We pray for the coming of God's Kingdom in all its fullness at Christ's return.
- When Jesus worked miracles/exorcisms etc He was giving a
   'foretaste' of what's to come.
- When miracles and revivals happen today we are experiencing a
  'foretaste/sample' of what's to come.
- When a person is truly saved a seed of the Kingdom of God is deposited within them which grows and shows itself.
- Then the Kingdom of God is 'within' us.
- If someone is a citizen of the Kingdom they will live in a way that befits the Kingdom being within them.

## 1 The Definition Of The Kingdom

- The word 'Kingdom' is translated from the Greek word 'basileia' which means, 'the reign/rule of God.'
- 'Thy Kingdom come.' The next line explains what 'Thy Kingdom come' means.

- · 'Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.'
- The Kingdom of God can be anywhere where His will is being perfectly done just as it is in heaven.
- When we say 'not my will but Your will be done' our heart becomes an 'enclave' of the Kingdom.
- Note the lyrics of the song: 'Reign in me, sovereign Lord reign in me.'
- Is the 'Kingdom of God' within you? If it is, the evidence of the Kingdom will be seen.

### 3 The Characteristic Of A Forgiving Spirit

- Consider the parable of the Kingdom in [Matthew 18:21 35].
- The one who the King has forgiven will have the characteristic of forgiving others. [Ephesians 4:32].

## 3 The Characteristic Of A Serving Spirit

- Consider the request of the mother of James and John to Jesus and His response to her.
- The Kingdom is not about being served but about serving others.
- Consider the example of the King Himself in [John 13]. Note the 7 things He did.
- The Kingdom is about a towel, not getting the best seat or position.

# 5 The Characteristic Of A Child-like Spirit

- Consider the example of Christ and the child in [Matthew 18:1 4].
- A child is **HUMBLE** [James 4:10]
- A child is **TRUSTING**. Trust what your heavenly Father says.
- May the Kingdom of heaven be withing us.
